SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS.

- 1. The event shall be conducted under the International Sporting code of F.I.A. the National Competition Rules of Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), these Supplementary Regulations and any further Supplementary Regulations. Additional instructions may be issued subject to NCR 69. CAMS Permit Number 416/3007/01.
- 2. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at <u>www.cams.com.au</u>.
- 3. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at <u>www.cams.com.au</u>.
- 4. The promoter of the event is the Northern Districts Sporting Car Club.
- 5. This event shall be a Multi-Club Touring Assembly, held on Saturday 30th July 2016 on Public Roads South East Queensland. The event shall begin in the shopping centre carpark at corner of Buckley Road & Uhlmann Rd, Burpengary and finish in Kilcoy.

7. ENTRIES:

- (i) Entries will open on Friday 3rd June 2016 and close at 5.00pm Friday 29th July 2016
- (ii) Entries should be emailed to the secretary jennifer_garth@optusnet.com.au.
- (iii) Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate entry fee of \$35. This can be paid by cash, cheque or direct debit.
 - a. Cheques are to be payable to 'Northern Districts Sporting Car Club'
 - b. Direct Debit shall be paid to: BSB 484-799 Account 501155954 with IOR and the drivers name as the reference. Proof of payment must be brought to the start of the event.
- (iv) Entries may be rejected if the entry form is not completely filled in correctly.
- (v) Promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry subject to NCR 83.
- (vi) The limit on the number of entries will be 50 cars. If the event is over-subscribed, the first 50 entries received will be accepted. The balance will be returned with a full refund.

8. LICENSES:

- The competitor (driver) must present a <u>Current Civil (e.g. Queensland) Drivers Licence</u> at sign on.
- Either the Driver or Navigator must present both a <u>Current CAMS affiliated Club Membership Card</u> and <u>Current CAMS L2NS</u> <u>licence</u> (or higher level) at sign on.
- A CAMS Vehicle Log Book for the vehicle. (If issued).

9. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:

- (i) All cars must be presented in a roadworthy condition.
- (ii) Competitor/ Driver must inspect and confirm that car is roadworthy and safe and sign safety section of the entry form.
- (iii) All traffic laws must be obeyed at all times.

10. THE EVENT:

- (i) Book in will be available from 7.00 am at the 'Just a Little Bit Naughty cafe, The Hub Shopping centre cnr. Uhlmann rd. and Buckley rd. Burpengary East. 07 54331151
- (ii) Once cars have completed all the paperwork and booked in instructions will be available from 8:00 am.
- (iii) There will be a compulsory drivers/navigators briefing at 8:45 am, and the event shall start after the drivers/navigators briefing. Probably 9:00am. Starting with car 1 then the following cars at two-minute intervals.
- (iv) The event is NOT timed and time taken to complete the event will NOT be a factor in determining the placings.
- (v) Awards may be given at the discretion of the Clerk of Course. Competitors shall be ranked to allow their navigation skills to develop.
- (vi) It is an offence for any of the competing clubs or competitors to use, or attempt to use, any portion of the venue for purposes other than what is approved;
- (vii) Dangerous and/or unsuitable cars and/or drivers and/or poorly presented cars may be excluded by the organisers at their

discretion;

- (viii) Competitors who do not hand in a completed answer sheet by 6.30 pm on the evening of the event will be deemed a non-finisher;
- (ix) The Clerk of Course may vary point (viii) at their discretion.
- (x) Competitors are reminded that protests are to be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.
- (xi) Event Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.
- (xii) Competitors will be advised contact details to the clerk of course if they are unable to finish the touring assembly.

11. JUDGE of FACT

- (i) The Clerk of Course or any person nominated by the Clerk of Course is a judge of fact to:
- (ii) The time of finish for any competitor
- (iii) Answer to questions
- (iv) Whether any competitor/s are using or attempting to use the event for a non-permitted use.

12. ALCOHOL

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crewmember that is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

13. Public Relations.

This event is conducted on public roads and competitors must be aware at all times that members of the general public may be using these roads. ALL traffic laws MUST be obeyed at all times. When parking at venues please show consideration for members of the general public who also use these venues. The police have been advised of the passing of this event.
