Lotus Club Qld Inc Lakeside DTC Timed Laps – Date: 16 July 2022

1. AUTHORITY:

This event is a multi-club speed event and will be conducted under and in accordance with RACERS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the RACERS website at <https://racers.world/documentation>

2. PROMOTER and ORGANISING COMMITTEE:

The promotor will be the Lotus Club Queensland Inc. and the organising committee will be as per Section 6 OFFICIALS below.

3. TIME, DATE AND LOCATION:

The event will be held at Lakeside Park Raceway, Driver Training Centre Lakeside Road, Kurwongbah 4503 on Saturday 16 July, from approximately 0800. to approximately 1600. The Lakeside DTC circuit is approx 800m in length.

4. PERMIT:

The event will be held under RACERS permit number TBA.

5. INSURANCE:

Please ensure all members of your party sign the Pit Crew sign on sheet in the Pavilion, so the Licensed drivers, Pit Crew and authorised officials are covered by Personal Accident Insurance under the terms of the RACERS Personal Accident Insurance.

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7. ELIGIBILITY OF COMPETITORS:

The event will be open to current members of Lotus Club Queensland and other invited Queensland Car Clubs and invited approved individuals.

The only competition licence accepted is a RACERS Annual Clubman or Day Licence.

The RACERS licence, current civil drivers licence and current Club membership cards will be required for scrutineering, document checking and driver sign on.

Those without a valid RACERS licence should apply on-line and create an account at www.racers.world

8. ENTRY CONDITIONS:

Entries open upon publication of these supplementary regulations and should be made via the Racers website. Entries will be accepted only if made via the Racers.world entry form and are fully completed by the "Bona fide owners" and the relevant fee has been paid prior to the day of the event.

Multiple entries are allowed in one car but a complete entry and fee is required for each driver. The Event Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry

PHONE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED, NOR WILL ENTRIES BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT.

9. EVENT SIGN ON

All drivers must sign into the event prior to Drivers Briefing. Event sign on will be conducted using the Racers App or online system and can be completed prior to arriving at Lakeside.

10. CANCELLATION OR POSTPONEMENT:

The Organisers reserve the right to alter or abandon the Event if the number of entries received by the closing date is, in their opinion, insufficient; or to alter or abandon the Event if any part of the course is rendered impassable.

In the event of a cancellation or postponement the Organisers will advise as soon as possible an alternate date and/or payment refund details.

11. FUEL & HAZARDOUS MATERIALS:

Fuel will not be available at the track and fuel is restricted to "Commercial Fuel", Leaded racing fuel is permissible.

Refuelling and other Hazardous materials are NOT permitted or to be done in the Staging/Pit area.

Please consult the Event Organiser for directions to a safe location for refuelling etc.



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12. SCRUTINY:

Scrutineering will commence at 0800 on the day of the Event and will close at 9.00 a.m.

ALL competing cars must be presented to the scrutineers on the day and bear their "OK" sticker before being permitted onto the circuit.

ALL COMPETITORS must present themselves for "DRIVER SIGN ON" prior to their cars' Scrutineering and produce a current RACERS competition licence, current car club membership card (if applicable) and civil driver's licence.

A CTP Extension is not required.

13. VEHICLE PREPARATION:

Road registered vehicles need no special preparation other than:

- Each throttle be fitted with a return spring
- All forward facing glass lights must be covered with a transparent adhesive film.
- Tyres are subject to scrutineer's approval.
- An approved Fire Extinguisher is not compulsory, but if fitted must be within easy reach of the driver whilst in a harnessed position
- Safety Cages are not compulsory but recommended for open cars.
- ALL drivers MUST wear an Australian Standard AS 1698 and/or CAMS approved helmet whenever on the circuit, seat belt or harness and goggles/visor (where applicable).
- A full face helmet must be worn in open cars.
- Flame Retardant Clothing from ankles to neck to wrists ie: 100% Cotton is acceptable. Clothing of flammable synthetic material, such as nylon, is NOT acceptable.
- Fully enclosed footwear whenever on the circuit. NO bare feet, thongs or scuffs etc allowed.
- Working brake lights are COMPULSORY on all vehicles.
- Any car suffering damage or mechanical failure during the Event must return to Scrutiny for inspection prior to continuing. Cars considered unsafe or unsuitable will be precluded from further competition.
- All vehicles participating at Lakeside Raceway must conform to the noise limit, on both a static test and trackside test, of 92 dB(A). The noise test shall be measured from a position 4.0 metre behind the exhaust at a 45 degree angle, with the engine running at $\frac{3}{4}$ maximum revs.

14. DRIVERS BRIEFING:

A COMPULSORY drivers briefing will be held adjacent to the DTC Staging/Pit area at approximately 0915. Any driver failing to attend this briefing may be excluded from the event. The Staging, Starting and single Timed Lap format will be explained during this briefing.



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15. EVENT RULES:

- The Event will start at 9.30am and finish at approximately 4.00pm.
- There will be a maximum of TWO cars on the circuit at any time, under the control of mid-track flag marshall.
- Cars will run in Numerical order, so the times are recorded against the correct Car/Driver.
- Please be ready and follow the instructions of the Staging Marshall.
- The Staging Lights are approximately 1 metre behind the START photocell.
- To Stage drive slowly forward until you get a "RED" Staging Light.
- The next car is "NOT" to start until given the "GREEN" Staging Light by the Start Marshall.
- Your Run Time will not START until you break the "START" Timing Sensor beam.
- The "FINISH" Sensor beam is over near the main track underpass.
- Drivers who are not at the start in the correct order may miss that run!
- At the finish, slow down quickly and drive slowly back to pits/parking/assembly area.
- If the Timing equipment malfunctions you will get a re-run after the last car in the group.
- If you have a problem please finish your lap or pull off the track and signal the Starter for assistance.

16. TRAFFIC/PARKING MANAGEMENT – COMPETITORS, SPECTATORS.

- Traffic Flow – all cars are to only enter the Staging/Pit area either via the gap in the traffic barriers at the Pavilion end of the Staging/Pit area or from the FINISH line.
- Competitors Vehicles – may park along either side of the Staging/Pit area or in the General parking area.
- Competitors – please reduce speed immediately once thorough the FINISH line and please return to the Staging/Pits area at a safe speed ie: speed limit 10klms.
- Aggressive/Dangerous driving - a driver will be ask to leave the circuit if deemed a danger to themselves or others. The DTC is not a drift event!
- No Parking is allowed between the Finish line and in front of the DTC Pavilion.
- No Spectators to sit or stand on the grass area on the track side of the DTC Pavilion.
- Trailers and General Parking – all Trailers and non-competing vehicles to be parked behind the Staging Area traffic barrier and in front of the dam.
- Please exercise personal care at all times with cars entering and leaving the Staging/Pit area.
- Tents and Shade Covers - No Tents or Shade Covers are to be erected on the inside of the Staging/Pit area as they obstruct the Timers and Spectators view of the track
- Restricted Areas – no one is to venture out onto any part of the track or the infield while there is a car on the track



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17. CLASSES, AWARDS AND POINT SCORE:

There are NO Classes, Awards or Point Score for the DTC Timed Lap. Series award will be judged across the season based on the following:

1. MOST IMPROVED - Measured against the driver's best time.
2. ROOKIE - For those doing their first season (measured as for 1).
3. MOST CONSISTENT - Like a regularity for those who do fast times and aren't likely to improve but do great laps.
4. FASTEST TIME - For the season/lap record.

18. TIMING AND TRANSPONDERS:

Timing for the DTC Timed Laps will be done by equipment owned and operated by Lotus Club Qld. No transponders are required.

19. USE OF PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES:

During the event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded.

Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol or other substances on the day of the event shall not be permitted to participate.

20. PENALTIES:

The Event Organiser may refer to the Judge of Driving Standards any driver who:

- (a) after leaving the circuit, re-joins the track at a speed considered dangerous to themselves, to any other competitor, or to any Official;
- (b) is observed driving in a manner dangerous to either themselves or other competitors;
- (c) disobeys the direction of an Official;
- (d) exceeds 10kph in the staging/pit area. Penalties may include exclusion.

21. RISK MANAGEMENT:

- Parents/Guardians have the responsibility of keeping their children (16 years & under) out of the pit area and form up grid during the running of the event.
- Non-Smoking – the Staging/Pit area a Non-Smoking area.
- Unregistered vehicles "MUST NOT" be driven outside the paddock area.
- In the event of an accident/any damage to facilities at Lakeside Park Raceway or use of a Fire Extinguisher the Lotus Club Queensland reserves the right to, and may, claim the cost from the competitor.
- Risk Management - please assist us regards identifying and reporting any hazards and risks, so the appropriate action can be taken to mitigate the risk or hazard.
